

**Norfolk County Council (Tasburgh)**  
**Emergency Notice**  
**Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026**  
**Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

Tasburgh (1334-9288-2912-1756) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to a burst water main the use by vehicles (of any class) of the U76022 Fairstead Lane from 30 metres east of its junction with A140 Ipswich Road for 60 metres eastwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Tasburgh will be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

Alternative route is via: Fairstead Lane, A140 Ipswich Road/ Norwich Road, Hempnall Road, Mill Road, The Street, Broaden Lane (Morningthorpe and Fritton, Hempnall, Tasburgh, Long Stratton).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Anglian Water.

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the Road or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 9<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> July 2026 but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 29<sup>th</sup> July 2026 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 29<sup>th</sup> July 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

Any existing restrictions or prohibitions within Orders made under the RTRA 1984 will become suspended where they conflict with the provisions of this Notice during the operation of this Notice.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

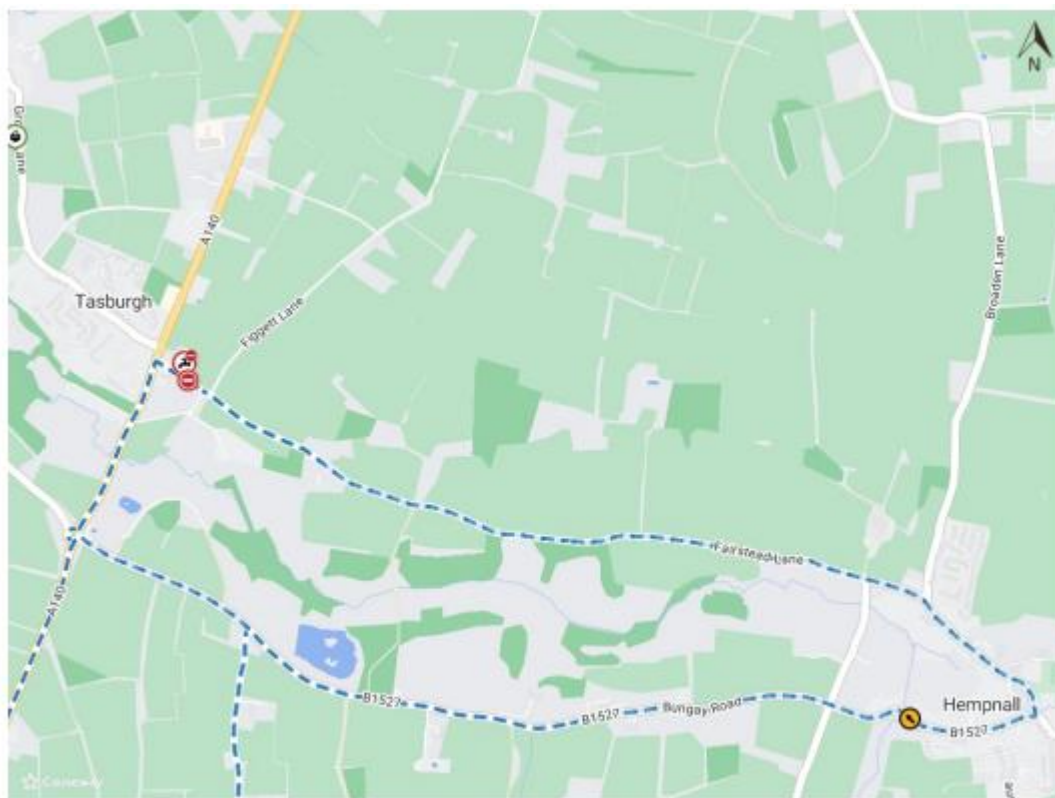
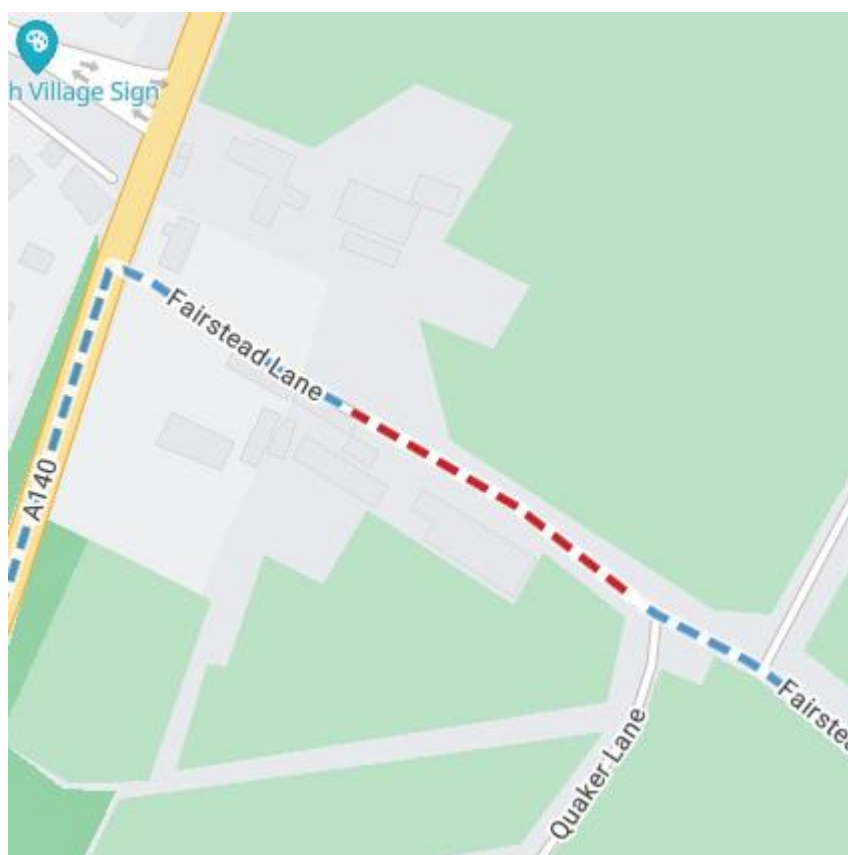
